

# Work on Columbus Monument Base To Begin Tuesday

Movement of stone for the base of the Columbus monument to be erected in St. Marys Circle from the Barge Canal Terminal to the monument site will be started on Tuesday, it was announced at the City Hall yesterday afternoon.

Mayor Roland B. Marvin after a conference with William W. Cronin, chief deputy city engineer, reported that a derrick and crane owned by the Bureau of Water would be moved from Skaneateles to the terminal to load the huge slabs of stone, some of which are reported to weigh six tons, on trucks.

Officers of the Columbus Monument Association and Dwight J. Baum, architectural consultant to the association, expect that erection of the monument will be completed by early July.
