
Monument Base, Tied Up by Storm, Due Here Tuesday

Base of the Columbus monument to be erected in St. Marys Circle was still at Sylvan Beach last night.

Due here the middle of last week in two State barges, the cargo has been held at the eastern end of Ononda Lake by storm conditions.

Guy W. Pinck, district State engineer, said last night that he expected the barges would arrive at the Barge Canal Terminal here either late tomorrow or Tuesday.

The State tug, Syracuse, left the local terminal yesterday morning for Sylvan Beach to bring back the barges. The tug, Governor Roosevelt, which brought the two boats as far as Sylvan Beach, was ordered back to the Mohawk River to act as an ice breaker during last week's storm.
