

# Columbus Statue to Remain Veiled One More Month



The statue of Christopher Columbus has just one more month to enjoy the protection from the weather, which, as may be seen from this photograph, the figure of the discoverer of America now has. The base, as the picture shows, is already visible to all Syracusans who pass through St. Marys Circle, but the draperies enfoldng the statue will stay there until the formal dedication and unveiling on Columbus Day, Oct. 12. Flowers which have been planted between the sidewalk and pool are begonias from Burnet Park Greenhouse. Augusto Rossi, ambassador from Italy to the United States, will be the chief guest of the occasion of the unveiling Columbus Day and a parade will precede the exercises.
